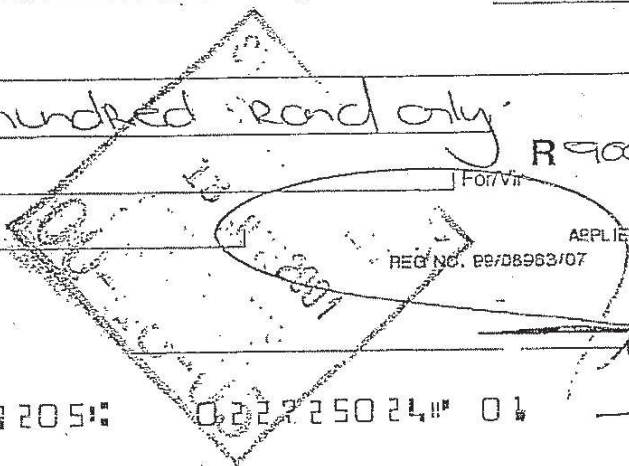

# Gumede 2 keer gewaarsku oor f-woord

## Sterenborg beweer:

- Kontrakte by Cell C en MTN is deur Gumede en GAST van ACT herlei;
- Gumede was nooit ernstig om ACT uit likwidasië te koop nie;
- Gumede, Brait en 'n Franse maatskappy het saamgesweer om hom uit ACT te skop;
- Gumede en ACT se likwidateurs het teen hom saamgesweer, en
- Gumede het hom by ACT aangesluit om hom te ondermyn.

Minr. Robert Gumede, ondervoorsitter van die genoteerde GijimaAST, sukkel om sy woorde te tel as hy opgewonde, ontsteld of ongeduldig raak.  
 Kommissaris Arnold Subel moes Gumede gister twee keer waarsku om nie die f-woord te gebruik as hy Applied Card Technologies (ACT) se vervaardigingsvermoëns beskryf nie.

Subel ondersoek die sake van die geïkwidateerde ACT wat Gumede gedeeltelik uit likwidasië gekoop het om as Gijima Afrika Smart Technologies (GAST) telefoonkaart vir Telkom te vervaardig.

Hy is gedagvaar om gister te getuig oor sy rol by ACT en beweer dat hy kontrakte van die maatskappy herlei het na GAST. Volgens Gumede was ACT in 'n baie haggelike toestand toe hy 2000 jaar aangekom het en kon maatskappy nie slinkkaarte vervaardig nie.

Hy verskil lynreg met minr. Sterenborg, 'n voormalige leier van ACT, se getuënis dat 'n wêreldklas-vervaardiger slinkkaarte was toe die maatskappy geleë was. Volgens Gumede was daar nie 'n tertiêre finansiële state vir 'n maatskappy nie en het die maatskappy nie plaaslike toerusting gekoop nie. Hy het sy hulp en invloed betrek om te help om 'n kontrakte te kry om Cell C aan ACT te gee.

Volgens Gumede het hy ACT met 'n R20 miljoen-inspuiting probeer red omdat die maatskappy "f---" gehad het.

Hierop het Subel Gumede se regsverteenwoordigers gevra om hom te kalmteer en gevra dat hy "eenvoudige" antwoorde op adv.

Michael van As, Sterenborg se advokaat, se vroeë verskaf.

"Maar dan moet hy nie my tyd mors nie," het Gumede gebrom. Gumede het voortgegaan deur te sê al waarmee Sterenborg goed was, was om "slegte stories aan mense te verkoop".

*"...So the Press is not unbiased. It has an agenda. In the same way as the media is anti-Catholic so it is profoundly anti-ANC. There is no balance in the way the media handles issues of transformation in SA. Mr Dawes you need to have a long hard soul search yourself".*

*"is it not that the Press has suddenly become much worse than it was five years ago or 10 years ago. In the recent years our media elite HAVE run amock before the elections and then just before the 2010 World Cup. The rogue element in our media became even more brazen in fabricating stories and concocting interviews, and using hoaxes to simply whip up hysteria over crime in SA... No other country in the world would these rogue journalists have been allowed to operate with such impunity by hiding behind our free speech rights".*

*"All that we are saying is that this so called media is not balanced, it is extremely one sided, I read this site just to see what anti Govt or anti ANC the M&G is gonna write next..."*

*"Mr Dawes should question his own and his newspaper's legitimacy before commenting! It seems this heroic editor has a short memory! Let us bring him into the light!*

*Yesterday, cmde Mantashe commented on the contempt of how the M&G's editor reacted to the Press Ombudsman ruling on the article on Gijima Ast's Robert Gumede! The M&G was supposed to apologise to Gumede but instead Mr Dawes seen fit to attack the ruling instead of just publishing the apology as ordered! This demonstrates quite clearly how editors treat their own ombudsman with contempt and that its time to totally abolish this farce".*

*"As far as Nic Dawes is concerned, he represents that which is very wrong with the current state of SA's media. **People like him have shown the press ombudsman and the press council the middle finger in their dealings, and have exposed the general SA media as nothing but revenue seeking, at – all – costs, self-proclaimed – untouchable, band of victims which has adopted the mantle of "official" opposition**".*

*"The Mail & Guardian which I have supported since being a student is now nothing more than a voice for disgruntled whites. Whites who cannot accept that transformation is hard work but needs to be done".*
